

Membership Rules

Harborough Valley Badminton Club (HVBC) are a friendly club open to players of all abilities from 14 years old.

HVBC runs on a respect system; members are expected to be friendly and courteous to other members. Members are expected to adhere to the following rules, and to ensure that fellow members do too;

- 1. MEMBERS ONLY to play, no membership = no play.
- 2. MEMBERS MUST SIGN THE REGISTER before playing and again when leaving each session.
- 3. AS A MEMBER YOU FULLY AGREE TO COMPLY with all HVBC rules, its constitution, codes of practice, child protection policy, anti-bullying policy, photography and filming policy. You shall obey all directions and instructions of the Committee Members and will always behave in a courteous and reasonable manner.
- 4. TRAINING SHOES MUST BE WORN in court area.
- 5. DO NOT WALK BEHIND COURTS WHEN IN PLAY, wait until play has stopped.
- 6. VACATE COURTS when your game is finished, especially if others are waiting.
- 7. MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO ENSURE NOBODY SITS FOR TOO LONG. If people are waiting at the side of the courts, singles play is not permitted. Please mix with sitting players especially new members.
- 8. RESPECT THE EQUIPMENT and it will give good service. No one likes playing with damaged equipment and it puts membership fees up.
